

TRAC match – January 27, 2026 – Larry Piercy, match director

Fourth Tuesday. Pistol / piston day. Weather forecast – 5 – 10 mph with gusts to 25 mph. What did we get? A nice mild day!! We had clear, cloudless skies, cool weather, breezy conditions with the usual swirling. Temps were 52° up to 63° with humidity in the upper teens. Wind started out around 7 – 8 mph but within the first half hour diminished to 3 – 5 mph, and then zero.

Larry's theme for today; Know Your Dope. We had 6 lanes with $\frac{1}{2}$ " killzones on each, at varying distances close up. The other targets were positioned from 25 out to 35 yards. It turned out to be a challenging course that would have been more challenging had the wind picked up as it did in past weeks.

We had 13 shooters today, all shooting either pistol or piston, save one puffer gunner. Scores were indicative of "Knowing Your Dope". For the record, "Dope" is defined as "Data Of Previous Experience". Here are the scores.....
